We received an IVAN report with the following description:
I was driving north on the 99 and saw a lot of burning happening east of the 99 just south of Laredo.

Conclusions:

December 16, 2024; 3:09 PM: Conclusion by Keira Truong: RI arrived at the complaint location and started driving around the grapevine Ag lands to find possible burn marks that would indicate the Ag burn. RI could not find any burn marks except for one stack of dried grapevine just 0.25 miles South of Lerdo (see EDMS). The stack did not appear to have been burned before. No burning odors were detected as well. RI surveyed the area but could not identify any burn marks.

No further action would be taken as the complaint was not confirmed. RI contacted RP and advised RP to contact the Air District if they continue to observe active burnings.

Findings:

December 16, 2024; 2:21 PM Contact by Telephone: Finding by Keira Truong: Reporting Inspection (RI) K. Truong contacted Reporting Party (RP) to gain additional information about the complaint. RP observed smoke from a grapevine agricultural burn East of HWY 99 while driving. RP stated that the smoke smelled like burning plastic. Since the RP was driving, they were not able to take any pictures. RP stated that they observed a stack of grapes being burned.
